- Staples Center: Hosts LA sports teams, as well as concerts.
- REDCAT, Walt Disney Concert Hall, and the Music Center: Encompasses the Ahmanson Theatre, Mark Taper Forum and Dorothy Chandler Pavilion. All present live music and theater performances, including nationally – touring theater productions and the Los Angeles Philharmonic.
