- **LA Live:** sports and entertainment complex that features popular dining venues, Regal Cinemas movie theatre, Lucky Strike Bowling Lanes, the interactive Grammy Museum, ESPN Zone, the Conga Room and the Nokia Theater. Located next to Staples Center
 - **Staples Center:** Hosts LA sports teams, as well as concerts.
